¹ Specific concerns raised by the Deputy Chairman regarding this discussion item include: (1) poverty rate of new arrivals, living conditions, single-parent percentage, educational attainment and employment of those new arrivals in poverty and their distribution by districts; (2) government policies to provide support for low-income new arrivals, and the targeted measures to help them address the above situation; and (3) since the handing down of the CFA's judgment on the residence requirement for CSSA, the relevant implications arising from the subsequent policy changes: including changes in the number of applications for CSSA, financial implications on the Government, and impacts on the poverty situation of new arrivals.
