## Subcommittee on Poverty

### Paper for the meeting on 29 October 2013

Subjects to be discussed at meetings in November 2013 to January 2014

#### Purpose

This paper seeks members' views on subjects to be discussed by the Subcommittee on Poverty ("the Subcommittee") at its meetings in November 2013 to January 2014.

#### Subjects to be discussed at its meetings

2. At the Subcommittee meeting on 28 February 2013, members agreed to decide on, at its monthly meeting, subjects to be discussed at meetings in the following three months. However, according to rule 26(c) of the House Rules, the Subcommittee should complete its work within 12 months of its commencement, i.e. by 5 November 2013. Otherwise, it should apply to the House Committee for an extension of the 12-month period.
