4.	<p>Noise pollution and mitigation measures</p> <p>Raised by Mr CHAN Han-pan, Dr Elizabeth QUAT, Mr Christopher CHUNG and Dr Kenneth CHAN at the meeting on 12 December 2012.</p> <p>Members wish to examine the following cases of noise pollution and their impacts on the health of the residents in the localities, as well as the mitigation measures taken by the Administration to address the cases:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) air traffic operation (e.g. aircraft noise) and its impacts on the residents in Ma Wan;(b) the noise nuisance caused by the flyover at Texaco Road in Tsuen Wan; and(c) the noise nuisance caused by the operation of the logistics industry, as in the case of Rambler Crest in Tsing Yi;(d) the noise nuisance caused by existing highways/flyovers running outside residential developments, particularly the flyover at Wan Po Road in Tseung Kwan O; and(e) construction works for transport infrastructure (e.g. railway depots and MTR construction sites).
