The Subcommittee on Poverty of the Legislative Council's House Committee continued its duty visit to Tokyo of Japan today (August 27).

The delegation visited the Children's Home of the Red Cross Japan in the morning to learn about its operation. The Children's Home provides support and caring services for children. In the afternoon, members of the delegation met with Prof Masahiro YAMADA, Professor of the Chuo University, to receive a briefing on poverty and employment problem in Japan and exchange views on related issues.
