When considering PWSC(2014-15)10, some PWSC members queried the basis and appropriateness of confining the planning, engineering and architectural study (the Study) under **770CL** to commercial development without prior investigation, and suggested other possible uses, including development of creative industries, logistics industry and columbarium, etc., be included in the scope of the Study. The Development Bureau noted Members' concerns and agreed that apart from commercial development, the Study will also ascertain the feasibility of other economic activities. The Development Bureau thereby proposes to expand the scope of the Study as detailed in paragraph 3(a) of PWSC(2014-15)10 to study the development of other economic activities in additional to commercial development as originally proposed.
