Action

I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 26th meeting held on 30 May 2014

(LC Paper No. CB(2)1673/13-14)

The minutes were confirmed.

II. Matters arising

Report by the Chairman on his meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration

2. The Chairman said that there was nothing special to report.

III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

(a) Legal Service Division report on bill referred to the House Committee in accordance with Rule 54(4)

Kowloon Tong Church of the Chinese Christian and Missionary Alliance Incorporation (Amendment) Bill 2014 (LC Paper No. LS57/13-14 issued vide LC Paper No. CB(2)1650/13-14 dated 29 May 2014)

- 3. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Legal Adviser</u> ("LA") briefed Members on the report prepared by the Legal Service Division ("LSD") on the Bill. <u>Members</u> considered it not necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Bill and did not raise objection to the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill.
- (b) Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on 30 May 2014 and tabled in Council on 4 June 2014 (LC Paper No. LS59/13-14)
- 4. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> briefed Members on the LSD report on the 11 items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 63 to L.N. 73) gazetted on 30 May 2014 and tabled in Council on 4 June 2014.
- 5. <u>Members</u> did not raise any questions on these items of subsidiary legislation.
- 6. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending these items of subsidiary legislation was the Council meeting of 2 July 2014.

IV. Further business for the Council meeting of 11 June 2014

Bills - First Reading and moving of Second Reading

Supplementary Appropriation (2013-2014) Bill

7. <u>The Chairman</u> said that the Administration had given notice to present the above Bill to Council on 11 June 2014.

Members' motions without legislative effect which had yet to be dealt with by the Council

- 8. <u>The Chairman</u> informed Members that the unfinished business on the Agenda of the Council meeting of 4 June 2014 would stand over to the Council meeting of 11 June 2014.
- 9. The Chairman further said that pursuant to the arrangement agreed at the House Committee ("HC") meeting on 23 May 2014 that not more than two Members' motions without legislative effect ("Members' motions") would be dealt with at each of the six Council meetings to be held between 4 June and 9 July 2014, as the two Members' motions originally scheduled for the Council meeting of 4 June 2014 would stand over to the Council meeting of 11 June 2014, the two Members' motions originally scheduled to be debated at the Council meeting of 11 June 2014 would be deferred to the Council meeting of 18 June 2014. The Chairman added that correspondingly, the two Members' motions scheduled for debate at each of the subsequent Council meetings would be deferred by one week, and that the two Members' motions originally scheduled for the Council meeting of 9 July 2014 would be deferred to the first regular Council meeting of the next legislative session. Members noted the arrangement.
- 10. In response to Ms Emily LAU's enquiry on the meeting arrangement for the Council meeting of 11 June 2014, the Chairman advised that the Council meeting would continue until 12:30 pm on Friday, 13 June 2014.

15. <u>Members</u> noted that the above two Members' motions would be postponed to the Council meeting of 25 June 2014.
