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Report No. 20/13-14 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 18 June 2014.

Subsidiary legislation considered

2. The House Committee has considered the following item of subsidiary legislation -

(1)	Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Civic Centres) (Amendment of Thirteenth Schedule) Order 2014 (L.N. 61/2014)	23 May 2014

3. The House Committee considered it not necessary to form a subcommittee to study the above item of subsidiary legislation.

Note: At the meeting on 23 May 2014, the House Committee formed a subcommittee to study three items of subsidiary legislation made under the Telecommunications Ordinance (Cap. 106) and gazetted on 16 May 2014. The President has given permission for Hon Charles Peter MOK, Chairman of the relevant Subcommittee, to move a proposed resolution at the Council meeting of 18 June 2014 to extend the period for amending the subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 9 July 2014. Details of the subsidiary legislation are as follows –

1. *Telecommunications (Method for Determining Spectrum Utilization Fee) (Administratively Assigned Spectrum in the 1.9–2.2 GHz Band) Regulation (L.N. 58/2014);*
2. *Telecommunications (Determining Spectrum Utilization Fees by Auction) (Amendment) Regulation 2014 (L.N. 59/2014); and*
3. *Telecommunications (Method for Determining Spectrum Utilization Fees) (Third Generation Mobile Services) (Amendment) Regulation 2014 (L.N. 60/2014).*
