To facilitate further discussion by the Subcommittee, <u>the Administration</u> was requested to provide information on the allocation of respective frequency spectrum/slots (with breakdown of relevant 2G, 3G and 4G spectrum) to the assignees under all existing assignments made through the Telecommunications Ordinance (Cap. 106).

## Way forward

5. <u>The Subcommittee</u> completed scrutiny of the Three Regulations. <u>Members</u> agreed to invite the public to give views in writing on the Three Regulations. Depending on the submissions received and the intention of interested parties to make oral representations, the Subcommittee might decide whether to conduct a public hearing.

(*Post-meeting note:* A notice on invitation for written submissions was posted on the website of the Legislative Council on 4 June 2014. Invitation letters were sent to the Chairmen of 18 District Councils for written submissions on the same date. By the closing deadline on 12 June 2014, four written submissions were received and five deputations indicated intention to make oral representations. The Chairman decided that the Subcommittee would meet with them at the next meeting subsequently scheduled for 17 June 2014.)

## Legislative timetable and extension of scrutiny period

6. <u>Members</u> generally supported the Three Regulations. They also agreed to extend the scrutiny period of the Three Regulations to the Council meeting of 9 July 2014. <u>Members</u> noted that the Chairman would move the relevant motion at the Council meeting of 18 June 2014.
