**Employment of ethnic minorities in  
Government-funded public bodies**


I refer to the request by the Panel on Public Service for information on the policies and measures adopted by Government-funded public bodies with regard to the employment of ethnic minorities (“EMs”), which was conveyed to the Civil Service Bureau and subsequently referred to this Bureau.

To gather the requested information, this Bureau has in consultation with other Government bureaux identified 40 Government-funded public bodies and collected the following information from these bodies –

- (a) all the 40 bodies confirmed that they follow the employment procedures as stated in the Code of Practice on Employment issued by the Equal Opportunities Commission under the Race Discrimination Ordinance; and

- (b) 26 of them have data on the number of EMs they employ. These 26 bodies employ a total of 20 041 employees, of whom 1 477 (~7.4%) are EMs.
