(Note: The normal / prescribed retirement age is 55 for officers on the Old Pension Scheme, and 60 for civilian civil servants and 55 / 57 for those in disciplined services grades on the New Pension Scheme or the Civil Service Provident Fund Scheme. Officers may apply to retire early after attaining the age of 45, 50 or 55 depending on their ranks and retirement schemes.)
