**Panel on Transport  
Illegal Carriage of Passengers for Hire or Reward  
by Light Goods Vehicles**

**List of Follow-up Actions**

The Panel on Transport discussed the captioned subject at its meeting on 18 July 2014. The Government's response to the list of follow-up actions required by Members of the Panel on Transport is set out below.

- (a) The number of cases in which light goods vehicles (“LVGs”), which provided illegal passenger carriage service, were involved in traffic accidents; and their passengers were not protected by the third party insurance.**

According to the Police's record, there was no case in which LGV, which provided illegal passenger carriage service, was involved in traffic accidents in 2013 and the first half of 2014.

**(b) The respective number of LGVs with seating capacity of two, three, four and five.**

As at end June 2014, there are 75,451 registered LGVs. The number of LGVs with different passenger seating capacity is set out in the following table:
