Meeting with deputations

<u>Members</u> noted that the following deputations were supportive of the Bill:

- (a) Hong Kong Bar Association;
- (b) The Law Society of Hong Kong;
- (c) The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors; and
- (d) Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre.

Discussion

2. On the justification to update the list of state parties to the Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards (1958) ("New York Convention") by amending the Schedule to the Arbitration (Parties To New York Convention) Order (Cap. 609 sub. leg. A), <u>Deputy Solicitor General</u> ("DSG") explained that it was to comply with the

obligations under the New York Convention to recognize and enforce arbitral awards made in contracting parties so that arbitral awards made in new contracting states to the New York Convention, such as Bhutan, could be enforced by Hong Kong courts and vice versa.

- 3. <u>Dr Priscilla LEUNG</u> asked whether the territory of "British Virgin Islands", proposed to be added to Cap. 609 sub. leg. A, also appeared in other local legislation. <u>DSG</u> replied in the positive. <u>DSG</u> explained that the reason for adding British Virgin Islands to the entry for the United Kingdom was that the United Kingdom had submitted a notification to extend territorial application of the New York Convention to the British Virgin Islands.
- 4. <u>Members</u> noted that the Secretary for Justice would move a Committee Stage amendment to add "State of Palestine" to Cap. 609 sub. leg. A, as the State of Palestine acceded to the New York Convention on 2 January 2015 and would become a new contracting party to the Convention on 2 April 2015. <u>DSG</u> said that the Administration had affirmed with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China, being a contracting party to the New York Convention, that the proposed addition of "State of Palestine" to Cap. 609 sub. leg. A was acceptable.
- 5. On the question as to whether amending Cap. 609 sub. leg. A was the only way to update the list of parties to the New York Convention, <u>DSG</u> replied that, in addition to amending Cap. 609 sub. leg. A by a bill, another way was for the Chief Executive in Council to declare by order in the Gazette that any State or territory was a party to the New York Convention under section 90(1) of the Arbitration Ordinance (Cap. 609).
- 6. Responding to the Chairman's question as to when the Bill would come into operation, <u>DSG</u> said that as the Bill was introduced to address the concern of some users of arbitration, the Bill, if passed by the Legislative Council, would come into operation upon publication in the Gazette as soon as practicable.

Way forward

- 7. The Chairman said that the Bills Committee had completed scrutiny of the Bill. The Bills Committee supported the Administration to resume the Second Reading debate on the Bill. The Administration would decide when the Second Reading debate on the Bill would be resumed in due course.
- 8. <u>Members</u> agreed that no further meeting would be held.
