## Follow-up to Meeting of the Finance Committee Held on 10 July 2015

## Item FCR(2015-16)29 Relating to PWSC(2015-16)30 7763CL – Integrated Basement for West Kowloon Cultural District

## **Issue**

At the Finance Committee meeting held on 10 July 2015, Hon Gary FAN noted that a total amount of 158 200 tonnes of construction waste would be generated in the first and second stages of the Integrated Basement for West Kowloon Cultural District (IBWKCD) construction works. Mr. FAN requested the Government to provide information on which construction sites the construction waste from IBWKCD would be delivered to, and for which public works projects such construction waste would be reused.

## **Response**

Of the total 158 200 tonnes of construction waste estimated to be generated from the first and second stages of the IBWKCD construction works under PWP Item No. 763CL, we plan to reuse about 101 380 tonnes (64%) of inert construction waste on the site within West Kowloon Cultural District (WKCD). We also plan to deliver and reuse about 55 620 tonnes (35%) of inert construction waste on other construction sites outside WKCD depending on their implementation programmes, actual works progress and demand for fill materials. In the coming few years, potential construction projects with public fill demand would possibly include, for example, Wan Chai Development Phase II Project and Southeast New Territories Landfill Project. In addition, an estimated remaining quantity of about 1 200 tonnes (1%) of non-inert construction waste will be disposed of at landfills.
