# NOTE FOR FINANCE COMMITTEE 

Variations to Funds on Account Approved by the Financial Secretary

The Vote on Account (VoA) Resolution approved by the Legislative Council (LegCo) on 18 March 2015 enables the Financial Secretary (FS) to approve variations to the funds on account in respect of any subhead, subject to the aggregate amount of the funds on account not being exceeded and that the variations must not exceed the provision for that subhead in the Estimates of Expenditure for 2015-16. To enhance transparency and in line with the established practice, the Government will report to the Finance Committee of LegCo if FS has exercised this authority to meet necessary requirements.
2. The details of variations to the funds on account as approved by FS Encl. under the VoA Resolution are set out at Enclosure.
