**Public Works Subcommittee
Meeting held on 24 June 2015
Supplementary Information**

On 24 June 2015, the Public Works Subcommittee (PWSC) recommended **110ET** be submitted to the Finance Committee (FC) for consideration. Members requested that the following supplementary information be provided –

Barrier-free access from Exit D3 of the Lai Chi Kok MTR Station to the proposed new site for the school

2. Details about the barrier-free access (BFA) from Exit D3 of the Lai Chi Kok MTR Station to the proposed new site for the school is set out at **Annex 1**. The locations of existing accessible lifts along the BFA are indicated at the location plan (Sheet 1) and photos of the key points along the BFA are enclosed (Sheets 2 to 7). Majority of the BFA facilities are operating 24 hours a day. The operating hours of the lifts and opening hours of the mall and footbridges along the BFA as stated in **Annex 1** have been confirmed with relevant parties including the Liberte Management Office, the Banyan

Garden Management Services Centre and Hoi Lai Estate Office. Since the opening hours of the Church of Christ in China Mongkok Church, Kai Oi School are from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., the opening hours of facilities along the BFA can cater for the need of the students and their parents.

3. As regards a member's suggestion of providing covered walkways along the BFA from Exit D3 of the Lai Chi Kok MTR Station to the proposed new site for the school with a view to improving the pedestrian facilities for the local community, as well as the future users of the proposed special school, we have relayed the suggestion to the Highways Department and Transport Department for consideration.

A list of basic facilities to be provided in a school for children with severe intellectual disability

4. Different types or scales of special schools would be provided with different facilities to meet the needs of their target students. For the provision of facilities in a special school for children with severe intellectual disability, please refer to the list of facilities as set out in paragraph 3(b) of the PWSC paper (Paper No. PWSC(2014-15)46) on a recent project proposing the construction of one special school for children with moderate intellectual disability and one special school for children with severe intellectual disability. Paragraph 3(b) of the said PWSC paper is extracted at **Annex 2** for members' reference. The above-mentioned project was endorsed by PWSC and approved by FC on 4 February 2015 and 27 February 2015 respectively.

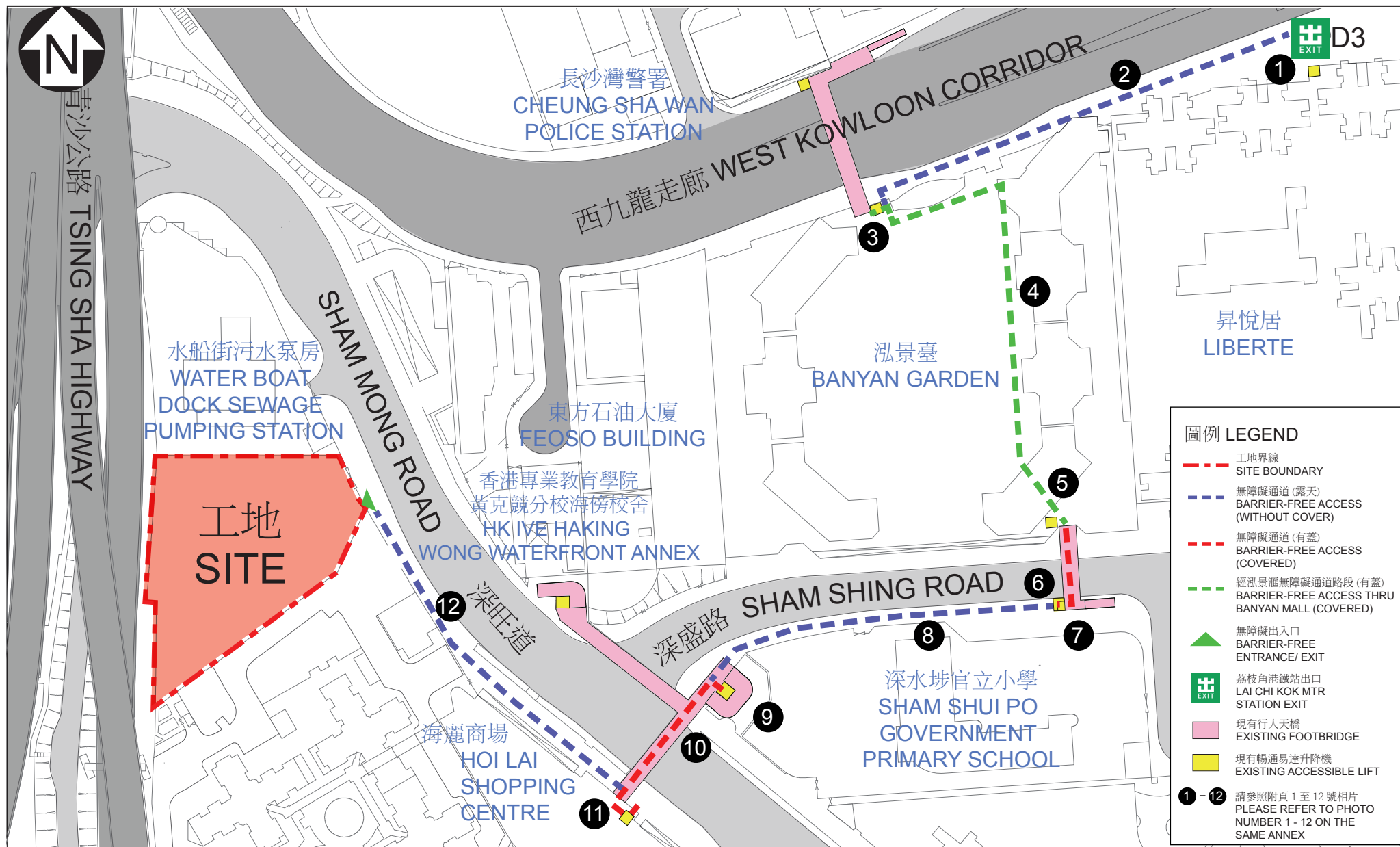

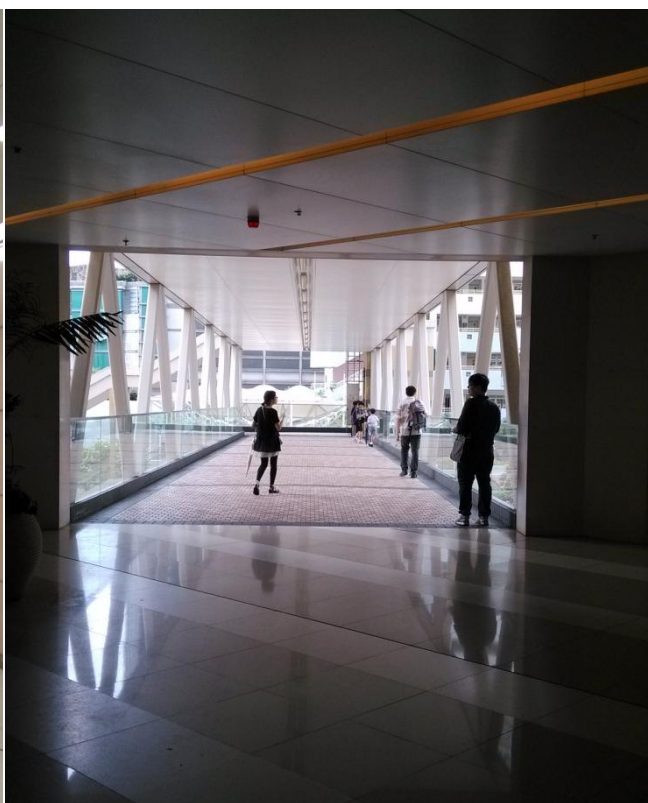
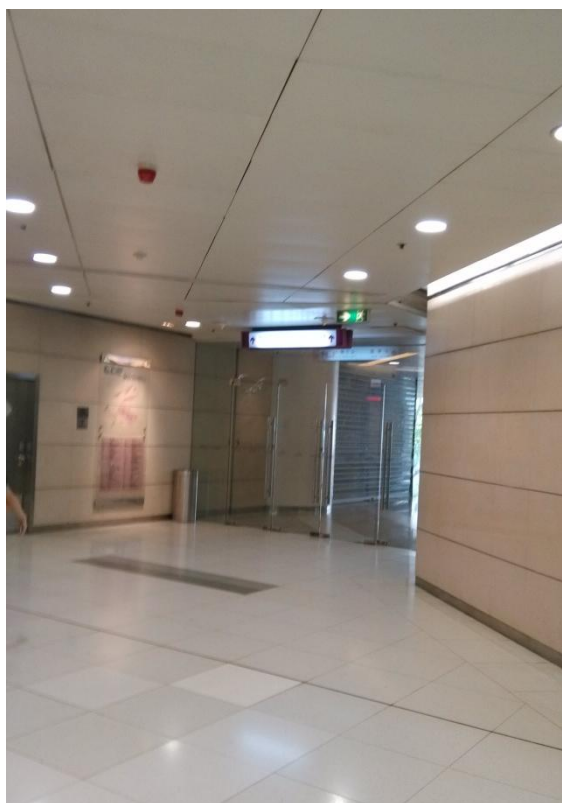

- (i) 12 classrooms;
- (ii) two small group teaching rooms;
- (iii) four special rooms, comprising a music room, a visual arts room, a multi-purpose room and a computer room;
- (iv) two interview rooms;
- (v) a special room for practical subjects²;
- (vi) a multi-media activity room;
- (vii) a physiotherapy room;
- (viii) an occupational therapy room;
- (ix) three speech therapy rooms;
- (x) a staff room;
- (xi) a staff common room;
- (xii) a social worker's room;
- (xiii) a conference room;
- (xiv) a student activity centre;
- (xv) a library;
- (xvi) a multi-purpose area;
- (xvii) a basketball court;
- (xviii) an assembly hall;
- (xix) a green corner; and
- (xx) other ancillary facilities including a disabled/fireman's lift,

Boarding section

- (xxi) bedrooms to accommodate 60 boarders and study area;
- (xxii) a TV/ common room;
- (xxiii) a dining/ multi-purpose room;
- (xxiv) a kitchen and a kitchen store;
- (xxv) a laundry room;
- (xxvi) a drying area;
- (xxvii) a warden's office;
- (xxviii) a houseparents' and programme workers' office;
- (xxix) a nurse duty room / a sick bay;
- (xxx) two sleep-in rooms for staff on night shift; and
- (xxxi) other ancillary facilities including stores, toilets, bathrooms, relevant facilities for the disabled, etc.
