I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 2nd meeting held on 17 October 2014

Report by the Chairman on his meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration

2. The Chairman said that there was nothing special to report.

III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation and non-legislative instrument gazetted on 17 October 2014

(LC Paper No. LS6/14-15)

- 3. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Acting Legal Adviser</u> briefed Members on the Legal Service Division report on the four items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 119 to L.N. 122) and one item of non-legislative instrument (i.e. The Fourth Technical Memorandum for Allocation of Emission Allowances in Respect of Specified Licences) ("The Fourth Technical Memorandum") (S.S. No. 5 to Gazette No. 42/2014) which were gazetted on 17 October 2014 and tabled in Council on 22 October 2014.
- 4. <u>Mr James TO</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Inland Revenue (Double Taxation Relief and Prevention of Fiscal Evasion with respect to Taxes on Income) (Republic of Korea) Order (L.N. 119) and the Inland Revenue (Double Taxation Relief and Prevention of Fiscal Evasion with respect to Taxes on Income) (Socialist Republic of Vietnam) (Amendment) Order 2014 (L.N. 120) in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr James TO agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.
- 5. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Overseas Lawyers (Qualification for Admission) (Amendment) Rules 2014 (Commencement) Notice (L.N. 122) in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. The Deputy Chairman agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.
- 6. <u>Ms Cyd Ho</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Fourth Technical Memorandum in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Ms Cyd HO and Mr WU Chi-wai agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.
- 7. <u>Members</u> did not raise any question on the Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Convention)(Amendment) Order 2014 (L.N. 121).
- 8. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending these items of subsidiary legislation and non-legislative instrument was the Council meeting of 19 November 2014, or that of 10 December 2014 if extended by a resolution of the Council.

VI. Report of Bills Committees and subcommittees

Report of the Subcommittee on District Court Equal Opportunities (Amendment) Rules 2014

(LC Paper No. CB(4)64/14-15)

15. Mr James TO, Chairman of the Subcommittee, briefed Members on the deliberations of the Subcommittee as detailed in its report. Members noted that as the motion to extend the scrutiny period of the Amendment Rules could not be dealt with at the Council meeting of 9 July 2014, the period for amending the Amendment Rules had expired at the said Council meeting. The Amendment Rules would come into operation on 1 November 2014.

VII. Position on Bills Committees and subcommittees

(LC Paper No. CB(2)125/14-15)

16. <u>The Chairman</u> said that as at 23 October 2014, there were 16 Bills Committees, eight subcommittees under the House Committee ("HC") and nine subcommittees on policy issues under Panels in action. One Bills Committee was on the waiting list.

VIII. Priority allocation of a debate slot for a motion debate on the Report of the Subcommittee on Integrated Education

(LC Paper No. CB(4)65/14-15)

17. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Dr Fernando CHEUNG</u>, Chairman of the Subcommittee on Integrated Education ("the former Subcommittee"), said that in view of the wide public concern over the policy and implementation of integrated education, the Panel on

Education had endorsed the former Subcommittee's recommendation to seek HC's support for priority allocation of a debate slot under rule 14A(h) of the House Rules to him, as Chairman of the former Subcommittee, for moving a motion for debate on the Report of the former Subcommittee ("the Report") at the Council meeting of 26 November 2014. The debate would provide an opportunity for Members to express views on the subject and for the Administration to respond.

18. <u>Members</u> agreed to the priority allocation of a debate slot to Dr Fernando CHEUNG for moving a motion on the Report at the Council meeting of 26 November 2014. <u>Members</u> also agreed to the former Subcommittee's proposal that in addition to the debate on the Report, only one other debate on a motion without legislative effect should be held at the Council meeting.
