I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 7th meeting held on 21 November 2014

II. Matters arising

Report by the Chairman on his meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration ("CS")

2. The Chairman said that he had conveyed to CS the requests of Dr KWOK Ka-ki respectively to invite CS to attend a special meeting of the House Committee ("HC") to discuss the drafting of the "Public Sentiments Report" and to follow up the rescheduled date for the Chief Executive ("CE")'s Question and Answer ("Q&A") Session. The two relevant letters from Dr KWOK had also been forwarded to CS. CS had

advised that she would relay Dr KWOK's enquiry on CE's Q&A Session to CE's Office. The Chairman added that it was his understanding that the Administration had replied direct to Dr KWOK on his request in respect of the "Public Sentiments Report".

Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on 21 November 2014 and tabled in Council on 26 November 2014 (LC Paper No. LS16/14-15)

At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Acting Legal Adviser</u> briefed Members on the Legal Service Division report on the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Public Pleasure Grounds) (Amendment of Fourth Schedule) (No. 2) Order 2014 (L.N. 140) which was gazetted on 21 November 2014 and tabled in Council on 26 November 2014.
