Action

I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 27th meeting held on 5 June 2015 (LC Paper No. CB(2)1668/14-15)

The minutes of meeting were confirmed.

II. **Matters arising**

Report by the Chairman on his meeting with the Chief Secretary for **Administration**

2. The Chairman said that there was nothing special to report.

III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on 5 June 2015 and tabled in Council on 10 June 2015

(LC Paper No. LS71/14-15)

- 3. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Legal Adviser</u> briefed Members on the report prepared by the Legal Service Division ("LSD") on the 14 items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 105 to L.N. 118) which were gazetted on 5 June 2015 and tabled in Council on 10 June 2015.
- 4. Mr Steven HO considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Import and Export (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2015 (L.N. 105); the Imported Game, Meat and Poultry (Amendment) Regulation 2015 (L.N. 106); and the Food Business (Amendment) Regulation 2015 (L.N. 107) in detail. Members agreed. Ms Cyd HO and Mr Steven HO agreed to join the proposed subcommittee. Members also agreed that the Chairman should, in his capacity as Chairman of the House Committee ("HC"), move a proposed resolution at the Council meeting of 24 June 2015 to extend the deadline for amending these three items of subsidiary legislation from the Council meeting of 8 July 2015 to the first Council meeting of the next session, so as to allow sufficient time for the proposed subcommittee to scrutinize the subsidiary legislation.
- 5. <u>Members</u> did not raise any question on the remaining 11 items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 108 to L.N. 118). <u>Members</u> noted that LSD was making enquiries with the Administration in relation to the legal and drafting aspects of the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution by Sewage) (Amendment) Regulation 2015 (L.N. 108), and would make a further report if necessary. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending these 11 items of subsidiary legislation would be the Council meeting of 8 July 2015.

IV. Further business for the Council meeting of 17 June 2015

Tabling of papers

The Chairman further said that as the Council meeting of 17 June 2015 would be adjourned after the proceedings on all items of business with legislative effect on the Agenda had been completed, the motion to take note of the Report would stand over until the Council meeting of 24 June 2015.
