## Report No. 17/14-15 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

## Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 22 April 2015.

## Subsidiary legislation considered

2. The House Committee has considered the following items of subsidiary legislation -

3. The House Committee considered it not necessary to form a subcommittee to study any of the above three items of subsidiary legislation.
