**Report No. 9/14-15 of the House Committee on Consideration of
Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments**

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 14 January 2015.

Subsidiary legislation considered

2. The House Committee has considered the following items of subsidiary legislation -

3. The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study items (1) and (2) in detail at its meeting on 21 November 2014. The Subcommittee reported its deliberations at the House Committee meeting on 19 December 2014 vide LC Paper No. CB(2)485/14-15.

4. In respect of items (3) and (4), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these two items of subsidiary legislation.

Note: The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study the Waste Disposal (Designated Waste Disposal Facility) (Amendment) Regulation 2013 (Commencement) Notice 2014 (L.N. 154/2014) and the Waste Disposal (Refuse Transfer Station) (Amendment) Regulation 2013 (Commencement) Notice (L.N. 155/2014) at its meeting on 19 December 2014. Hon Cyd HO, Chairman of the Subcommittee, has given notice to move a proposed resolution at the Council meeting of 14 January 2015 to extend the period for amending these two items of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 4 February 2015.
