Premises-related issues

- (a) with reference to paragraph 8 of the Administration's paper [LC Paper No. CB(4)627/14-15(01)] regarding the amount of rent reimbursed by kindergartens, provide information on the highest amount of monthly rent reimbursed by a kindergarten under the rent reimbursement scheme;
- (b) provide information on the numbers of local non-profit-making kindergartens and other local kindergartens;
- (c) where practicable, provide the information on the respective number of non-profit-making kindergartens and other local kindergartens operated in each type of school premises (such as public housing estates, properties owned by respective sponsoring organizations, privately leased premises etc.) and the average monthly rents payable by kindergartens operating in each type of school premises; and

Issues related to manpower requirement, salary scale and teacher professionalism

(d) with reference to paragraph 4 of the Administration's paper [LC Paper No. CB(4)627/14-15(02)] regarding the monthly salaries of teachers working full-time in kindergartens under the Pre-primary Education Voucher Scheme, provide information where practicable on the average monthly salaries of kindergarten teachers by their years of service.
