Meeting with the deputations and the Administration

- Admin 2. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to provide the following information
- (a) information relating to current registered hawker assistants, including the number and their years being registered, and their background such as the number of dependents in the families;
- (b) an elaboration on the ways in gestating bottom-up proposals, including
  - (i) the parties responsible for initiating district-led and bottom-up hawking proposals; and
  - (ii) the assistance provided by the Administration in setting up district-based committees/communication platforms for stakeholders including stallholders, affected residents and shopkeepers as well as district members, to exchange views on specific needs of the district concerned and to identify the types of hawking activities suitable for the district with community consensus;
- (c) the feasibility for the Administration to assist in gestation and implementation of bottom-up proposal with community support, which would then become a successful model proposal for other districts to follow; and
- (d) fine-tuned principles for formulation of hawker policy and proposed measures in addressing the views and concerns expressed at the meetings.
