Land Registry statistics for May

The Land Registry today (June 2) released its statistics for May 2015.

Land registration

- The number of sale and purchase agreements for all building units received for registration in May was 6,839 (+9.9% compared with April and +0.8% compared with May 2014)
- The 12-month moving average for May was 7,529 (0.1% above the 12-month moving average for April and 43.8% above that for May 2014)
- The total consideration for sale and purchase agreements in May was \$48.7 billion (+9.2% compared with April and +23.3% compared with May 2014)
- Among the sale and purchase agreements, 5,168 were for residential units (+13.6% compared with April but -1.9% compared with May 2014)
- The total consideration for sale and purchase agreements in respect of residential units was \$40.2 billion (+15.2% compared with April and +26.2% compared with May 2014)

Statistics on sales of residential units do not include sale and purchase agreements relating to sales of units under the Home Ownership Scheme, the Private Sector Participation Scheme and the Tenants Purchase Scheme unless the premium of the unit concerned has been paid after the sale restriction period.

Figures on sale and purchase agreements received for the past 12 months, the year-on-year rate of change and breakdown figures on residential sales have also been released.

As deeds may not be lodged with the Land Registry until up to 30 days after the transaction, these statistics generally relate to land transactions in the previous month.

Land search

• The number of searches of land registers made by the public in May was 420,566 (+3.6% compared with April and +5.5% compared with May 2014)

The statistics cover searches made at the counter, through the self-service terminals and via the Integrated Registration Information System Online Services.



The Land Registry Chart showing the number of Sale and Purchase Agreements of building units from May 2014 to May 2015


