 - (a) training and professional development as well as employment prospects of Chinese medicine practitioners ("CMPs"), Chinese medicine graduates and Chinese medicine pharmacists;
 - (b) manpower planning of CMPs and other healthcare personnel for the development of public Chinese Medicine Centres for Training and Research and the proposed Chinese medicine hospital;
 - (c) operation and management of the proposed Chinese medicine hospital;
 - (d) collaboration of CMPs and Western medicine doctors in the provision of clinical services to patients, and the implementation of Integrated Chinese-Western Medicine Pilot Project in public hospitals;
 - (e) regulation of proprietary Chinese medicines ("pCm") in respect of the manufacture, clinical trial and registration of pCm;
 - (f) testing and certification of Chinese medicines, as well as the harmonization of standards of Chinese medicines between Hong Kong and the Mainland;

- (g) introduction of the Good Manufacturing Practice ("GMP") requirement in respect of pCm in Hong Kong; and
- (h) development of electronic healthcare record system in the Chinese medicine sector.
- 5. <u>Members</u> also agreed that where necessary, Chinese medicine organizations and deputations would be invited to give views on specific issues.
