Legislative Council Panel on Public Service Follow-up to the Meeting on 15 December 2014

At the meeting of the Legislative Council Panel on Public Service on 15 December 2014, the Administration was requested to provide the following information relating to the employment of non-civil service contract (NCSC) staff -

- (a) breakdown of full-time NCSC staff for those Bureaux/Departments/Offices (B/Ds) engaging 500 or more NCSC staff as at 30 June 2014 by work types/positions and that of 10 years ago;
- (b) breakdown of the length of service of the 1 178 full-time NCSC staff employed by the Education Bureau (EDB) as at 30 June 2014; and reasons of employment or initiatives for engaging such NCSC staff; and
- (c) breakdown of the length of service of the 287 full-time NCSC staff employed by the Radio Television Hong Kong as at 30 June 2014 by less than one year, one year to less than three years, and three years or above.

2. Regarding paragraph 1(a) above, a breakdown of full-time NCSC staff for those B/Ds engaging 500 or more NCSC staff as at 30 June 2014 (namely Hongkong Post, Leisure and Cultural Services Department, EDB, Electrical and Mechanical Services Department and Department of Health) by work types/positions and that of 10 years ago is at <u>Annex A</u>.

3. Regarding paragraph 1(b) and (c) above, the details are set out at <u>Annexes B and C</u> respectively.

Note: There is a practical need for Hongkong Post, as a trading fund department, to engage an NCSC workforce to augment the core complement of civil service staff to cope with fluctuations in mail traffic which are difficult to predict and are beyond its control. In fact, there had been a marked increase in the mail traffic between 2004 and 2014. In addition, NCSC staff are also engaged to cope with the particular work pattern in mail processing. The figure as at end June 2014 indicates that more than half of the NCSC staff worked less than the conditioned hours required of civil servants.

Note: Government schools may engage full-time NCSC staff under various funds/grants to meet different short-term service needs. A number of cash grants, such as Learning Support Grants and Senior Secondary Curriculum Support Grant, have been introduced since the 2003/04 school year. In addition, government schools are given the flexibility to hire the right mix of supporting staff to meet their operational needs under the Funding Flexibility Scheme (FFS). There had been an increase in the number of NCSC staff engaged for janitor services under the FFS since the 2003/04 school year. The figure as at end June 2014 indicates that around half of the full-time NCSC staff engaged by EDB were employed to meet service needs which were time-limited or seasonal in nature, while the other half were employed to meet service needs where the mode of delivery of the service was under review or likely to be changed, such as those engaged under the FFS.
