Progress and financial situation of the construction of the Hong Kong Section ("HKS") of the Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link ("XRL") | 22 November 2013 | The Administration/MTRCL were requested to make arrangement for Subcommittee members to attend a site visit at an appropriate time after the delivery of the first set of high speed rail train to the Hong Kong site in 2014. | The Administration's response was issued vide LC Paper No. CB(1)782/13-14 (01) on 23 January 2014. According to the Administration, the first XRL train is expected to be delivered to Hong Kong in the second quarter of 2014. |
