I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

Dr Fernando CHEUNG and Miss CHAN Yuen-han were elected Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Subcommittee respectively.

II. Schedule of meetings and item(s) for discussion

2. The Subcommittee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

3. Members suggested the following items for discussion at future meetings -

- (a) statistics, definition, identification, assessment of domestic violence and sexual violence;
- (b) shelter service for victims of domestic violence and sexual violence;
- (c) services and support for high-risk families, in particular single-parent families and young couples, as well as male victims of domestic violence and sexual violence;
- (d) the effectiveness of the preventive measures taken by the Government and the relevant organisations against domestic violence and sexual violence, particularly early intervention, in meeting the latest needs of families;
- (e) Police's handling of cases of domestic violence and sexual violence, including the training and procedural guidelines provided for frontline police officers in dealing with these cases and the classification mechanism adopted, and Police's support for those involved in these cases to undergo the related judicial proceedings;
- (f) community mental health support services for the prevention of domestic violence and sexual violence; and
- (g) provision of support and specialised services for sexual minorities when encountering domestic violence and sexual violence.

4. Members agreed to discuss and receive views from deputations on the definition, identification and assessment of domestic violence and sexual violence at the next meeting. The Chairman advised that members would be informed of the date of next meeting and the schedule of subsequent meetings in due course.
