LegCo delegation visits Federal Ministry of the Interior of Germany (with photos)

The delegation of the Legislative Council ("LegCo") began its visit in Berlin, the capital of Germany yesterday (2 March).

On the first day of visit, the delegation met Dr Ole SCHRÖDER, the Parliamentary State Secretary of the Federal Ministry of the Interior ("the Ministry"). He briefed delegation members on the work of the Ministry and the role of the parliamentary state secretary. He also shared his experience with delegation members on how his position enabled him to strengthen the working relationship between the Ministry and the Parliament of Germany.

The delegation then held a discussion session with Dr Henner Jörg BOEHL, the Head of Division for Election Law and Political Party Law of the Ministry and learnt about the political and electoral systems of Germany.
