## **Government Bill**

### Committee stage

— Appropriation Bill 2016 : The Financial Secretary

(During the Committee stage of the Bill, the meeting was suspended at 7:44 pm on 4 May and resumed at 9:00 am on 5 May, and was suspended at 7:53 pm on 5 May and resumed at 9:00 am on 6 May 2016.)

The Council went into committee to continue the consideration of the Schedule to the Bill. The committee continued the fourth debate under the theme of “Land, Housing,

Transportation, Environment and Conservation”. After Members and a public officer had respectively spoken on the amendments, the fourth debate came to a close.

The Chairman ordered a joint debate on the fifth and the sixth debates under the themes of “Economic Development” and “Education, Manpower, Youth, Arts and Culture and Sports”, covering 129 amendments to 27 heads as set out in the Official Record of Proceedings. Members spoke on the amendments. Hon CHAN Chi-chuen drew the attention of the Chairman to the absence of a quorum. The Chairman then directed the Members to be summoned.

### **Next meeting**

After 15 minutes had expired, a quorum was not present. The Council then resumed. The President adjourned the Council in accordance with Rule 17(2) of the Rules of Procedure until 11:00 am on 11 May 2016.

The Council was adjourned at 9:15 am on 6 May 2016.
