

Fixed Penalty (Public Cleanliness Offences) (Amendment) Bill 2015
Debate and voting arrangements

Main object of the Bill : To amend the Fixed Penalty (Public Cleanliness Offences) Ordinance (Cap. 570) (“Ordinance”) to provide for a fixed penalty system for the offence of obstruction of public places under section 4A of the Summary Offences Ordinance (Cap. 228).

First debate	: Clauses with no amendment – Clauses 1, 2, 4, 5 and 10
Voting	: To vote on the above clauses standing part of the Bill
Second debate	: Clauses with amendments – Clauses 3, 6 to 9 proposed by Hon WONG Yuk-man
Joint debate -	To conduct a joint debate on the above clauses and the amendments. The amendments seek to add the word “Offences” after “Public Cleanliness and Obstruction” in the short title of the Ordinance and in the relevant references to such short title in related Ordinances and Regulations.

Clause 7(13) and (15)	Fixed Penalty (Public Cleanliness Offences) Regulation (Form 3)
Clause 8	Criminal Procedure Ordinance (Cap. 221)
Clause 9	Rehabilitation of Offenders Ordinance (Cap. 297)
Voting	: To vote on the above amendments together, and then the original clauses or the clauses as amended standing part of the Bill
