The Funding Scheme for Youth Exchange in the Mainland and the Funding Scheme for Youth Internship in the Mainland aim to sponsor Hong Kong youth aged 12 to 29 and 18 to 29 respectively, and holding a valid Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card, to take part in the exchange or internship programmes in the Mainland. The recruitment work for the youth exchange and youth internship programmes is planned and organised by individual sponsored organisations according to their own programme proposals. In general, the targeted participants for these youth exchange and youth internship programmes are not limited to members of the sponsored organisations.

Question:

As regards Reply Serial No. HAB131, in response to the question on how the Home Affairs Department would deal with cost overrun should the cost of projects under the Signature Project Scheme (SPS) exceeded \$100 million, the Government merely replied that it would strive to implement the SPS projects within \$100 million with measures. At present, 16 SPS projects have yet to obtain funding approval from the Finance Committee. Should there be any cost overrun of the SPS projects, will additional provision be allocated to cover the overrun? If yes, what are the details? If no, what are the reasons?

Reply:

Under the Signature Project Scheme (SPS), a provision of \$100 million has been earmarked for each District Council (DC) to implement 1 to 2 projects. In a bid to implement the SPS projects within the government commitment of \$100 million for each district, we have exercised due diligence in conducting the preparatory and pre-construction works for the projects so as to, inter alia, make the best estimates for project cost in respect of each SPS project.

In the event that the tender price for the construction works of a particular SPS project is higher than the estimated project cost, the relevant DC may, subject to no deviation from the proposed scope of works as approved by the Finance Committee, consider ways including adjusting the project details, etc. to contain the construction cost within the \$100 million cap.

Question:

In Reply Serial No. HAB105, the Home Affairs Department (HAD) indicated that a total of 10 bid-rigging complaints were received in the past 2 years (2014-15 and 2015-16). In this connection, please advise of the following:

- (a) how did HAD handle and follow up on the above 10 complaint cases?
- (b) did HAD make referral of the bid-rigging complaint cases to other relevant departments and provide them with support as appropriate during investigation and enforcement? If yes, what are the details? If no, what are the reasons?
- (c) upon receipt of complaints against suspected bid-rigging activities, would HAD provide the complainants with analysis on the nature of the bid-rigging involved and also specific technical and professional assistance, and then advise them to report to the Competition Commission, Hong Kong Police Force or Independent Commission Against Corruption? After making the advice, would HAD communicate with the departments/authorities concerned and provide them with prior information of the cases? If yes, what are the reasons?
- (d) would HAD collaborate with the dedicated teams of other relevant departments to explore ways to combat illegal bid-rigging activities in the near future?

Reply:

- (a) to (c) For cases involving suspected bid-rigging activities, we will advise the complainants to report the cases to the Competition Commission. For cases involving suspected criminal offences or corruption elements, we will advise the complainants to report the cases to the Hong Kong Police Force (Police) or the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC) for investigation. We do not have the statistics on the follow-up action of these cases.
- (d) The Government is very concerned about unlawful activities (such as suspected bid-rigging) in building repair and maintenance works. Relevant departments and organisations, including the ICAC, the Police, Home Affairs Department, Buildings Department, the Urban Renewal Authority and the Hong Kong Housing Society, have been working closely together and adopting a multi-pronged approach, through measures such as publicity and education, procedural enhancement, provision of better support for owners' corporations and owners as well as active investigation and enforcement actions, to prevent unlawful activities in the course of building maintenance works.

The ICAC and the Police have respectively set up their dedicated units to proactively investigate reports of offences related to building management and maintenance within their purviews in accordance with the law, and instigate prosecutions upon sufficient evidence. The Competition Ordinance came into effect on 14 December 2015. Question:

This is a follow-up to Reply Serial No. HAB135 which states that over 200 complaints on building management and maintenance involving disputes among owners and owners' corporations (OCs) have been received in each of the past 3 years, of which, 10 complaints were related to bid-rigging activities in building maintenance, received in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The cases concerning building maintenance disputes have not decreased in the past 3 years. Does this mean that the existing legislation is not a sufficient deterrent? Will the Government consider introducing new legal provisions and strengthening penalties to target bid-rigging activities in building maintenance and to reduce disputes among owners and OCs? If yes, what are the details? If no, what are the reasons?

Reply:

The Government is very concerned about unlawful activities (such as suspected bid-rigging) in building repair and maintenance works. Relevant departments and organisations, including the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC), the Hong Kong Police Force (Police), Home Affairs Department (HAD), Buildings Department, the Urban Renewal Authority and the Hong Kong Housing Society, have been working closely together and adopting a multi-pronged approach, through measures such as publicity and education, procedural enhancement, provision of better support for owners' corporations (OCs) and owners as well as active investigation and enforcement actions, to prevent unlawful activities in the course of building maintenance works.

The ICAC and the Police have respectively set up their dedicated units to proactively investigate reports of offences related to building management and maintenance within their purviews in accordance with the law, and instigate prosecutions upon sufficient evidence. The Competition Ordinance (Cap. 619) came into effect on 14 December 2015. If the competitors agree to rig bids or engage in other cartel behaviour, the Competition Commission can commence investigations and take legal proceedings at the Competition Tribunal to impose penalty on the persons concerned. Members of the public may lodge enquiries or complaints with the Competition Commission if they discover any suspicious bid behaviour or bidding pattern.

HAD conducted a public consultation exercise on the review of the Building Management Ordinance (Cap. 344) (BMO) from November 2014 to February 2015. During the consultation period, we met with the 18 District Councils, the Legislative Council Panel on Home Affairs (HA Panel), owners' and residents' organisations, relevant trade and professional organisations, etc. to gauge their views. By the end of the consultation period, we received over 1 400 written submissions. We will report the outcomes and the proposed way forward to the HA Panel shortly.

During the public consultation exercise, some suggested that more criminal sanctions should be added to the BMO to deter people, including members of the management committee (MC), from breaching the requirements of the BMO. Under the existing BMO, the Lands Tribunal has the jurisdiction to hear and determine any proceedings relating to the interpretation and enforcement of the provisions of the BMO and the deed of mutual covenant, powers and duties of the OC, etc. As owners serve as MC members on a voluntary basis, many of them consider that it would be unfair to subject them to criminal liability. We will continue to encourage owners to participate in the management of their buildings and assist them to fulfil their building management responsibilities through various kinds of support services.

Question:

In Reply Serial No. HAB196, the Government only provided information on the top 10 titles acquired in 2015-16 for lending with breakdown by adult and junior type and by language. Information on further breakdown by classification, as well as expenditure incurred on each title was not readily available due to system limitation. As a follow-up, can the Government provide the information later?

Reply:

Based on the experiences of the Hong Kong Public Libraries (HKPL) in compiling the information in Reply Serial Nos. HAB217 and S-HAB20 in the context of the examination of Estimates of Expenditure in 2014-15, and HAB234 and S-HAB06 in 2015-16, further breakdown of the most acquired top 10 titles by classification for Chinese and English adult and children books would entail a very labour-intensive manual compilation of information for checking, sorting, verification and compilation of the data from related files. In view of the system constraint and the availability of resources, the HKPL can only provide the most acquired top 5 titles by classification for adult and children books in 2015-16 in June 2016.^{Note}.

Question:

- (1) In Reply Serial No. HAB207, it is pointed out in the question that the average usage rates of sports grounds reached 99% while the average usage rates of natural turf pitches reached 100%. However, the Government plans to provide only 1 more natural turf pitch, which is in Tuen Mun District, in the coming year. Will the Government provide more natural turf pitches? If so, what are the details? If not, what are the reasons? On the other hand, the Leisure and Cultural Services Department plans to convert more existing natural turf pitches into artificial turf pitches in 2016. Yet, the fact is that natural turf pitches and artificial turf pitches are clearly different and cannot substitute for each other. Football players prefer natural turf pitches. Have the Football Association and local football clubs been consulted on the measure? If so, what are the details? If not, what are the reasons?

Asked by: Hon TANG Ka-piu

Reply:

Football is a sport that can be played and enjoyed on many types of surface. In planning new football pitches, the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) takes into account many factors such as the policy objectives for sports development, demand of the whole community and individual communities, utilisation rates of existing facilities, site availability, the views of the District Councils and relevant “national sports associations” (NSA) concerned.

The LCSD is planning 1 new sports ground with natural turf pitch in Tuen Mun district. As regards artificial turfs, Third Generation (3G) artificial turf pitches are approved by the Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA) as suitable for football activities and are used by many countries and regions for football training and competitions. For the conversion of natural turf football pitches into artificial turf pitches, the LCSD has consulted the relevant District Councils and NSAs, including the Hong Kong Football Association and the Hong Kong Rugby Football Union. They support the use and additional provision of 3G artificial turf pitches for their training and competitions. In view of the advantages of artificial football pitches which can be used for 270 sessions per month (i.e. 4 times that of natural turf pitches), the LCSD plans to provide two more 3G pitches in 2016 by converting existing natural turf pitches and provide another 3G pitch under an open space project by 2017-18.
