PWP Item No. 53WS Uprating of Chai Wan Salt Water Supply System Follow-up to Meeting on 24 May 2016

The Administration, after consultation with the relevant departments, provides the supplementary information as requested by the Panel as follows:

- (a) whether the existing capacity of the sewage system serving Chai Wan and Siu Sai Wan is sufficient to meet the demand of the population at present; and
- The existing sewage collection and treatment system serving Chai Wan and Siu Sai Wan is sufficient to meet the demand of the population at present.
- (b) whether the capacity of such sewage system will be enhanced to cope with the future demand arising from the uprating of output capacity of the Siu Sai Wan salt water pumping station and the increased population in the area.
- The Environmental Protection Department is conducting a review of the sewage collection and treatment system for the catchment, and will make recommendations to ensure the capacity is sufficient to cope with the future demand up to 2024 and beyond if necessary.
