Redefining the social security –local social security needs reform!

The existing system of allowance for disabled person seems to be far from appropriate. In fact the concept of "100 handicap" is exclusive in Hong Kong. How does one qualify 50. Or 100 of disability? Does the one who was classified as 50. Disability have the sharp "half" of difficulties as a 100. Disabled do? And What I have to tell you is that: In the society, one who have 50. Disability has all difference from the 100. One-they all c't have a job!

Hong Kong preaches inclusion and practices exclusion. It's not worth it at all, but this is what we do when it comes to disability. It is the testimonials and inspiring stories which overlooked "what a disabled person want" by branding it with the ways a person overcome his drawbacks. My friend, giving me claps won't make us able!

Therefore, we've heard the voice. The classification of disability is preferred in the manner of degree rating, and take the "drawbacks" as the factor of classification (rother than "impairment" itself). In addition, all disabled persons deserve security benefits, regardless of the level he is. In the package of social security, moreover, the grant of living aids should come under the system of disability benefits.

It's not just a social benefit, but this is the issue to have people with functions limited live their lives unlimited. All these reform require limited funding and unlimited determination-whilst the fame of our president limited.

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
