#### **INTRODUCTION**

Section 27(1) of the Noise Control Ordinance (Cap. 400) ("Ordinance") empowers the Secretary for the Environment, after consultation with the Advisory Council on the Environment ("ACE"), to make regulation under the Ordinance. In accordance with section 27(2) of the Ordinance, any regulation made under section 27(1) relating to the payment of fees may provide for different fees to be charged according to different circumstances.

- 2. In exercise of this power, the Secretary for the Environment has made the Amendment Regulations at Annexes A to C to revise the fees specified in the respective subsidiary legislation listed below
  - (a) Noise Control (General) Regulations (Cap. 400 sub. leg. A)
  - (b) Noise Control (Air Compressors) Regulations (Cap. 400 sub. leg. C)
  - (c) Noise Control (Hand Held Percussive Breakers) Regulations (Cap. 400 sub. leg. D)

#### **BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATIONS**

- 3. The fees specified in the said regulations are for the processing of applications for Construction Noise Permits ("CNPs") and Noise Emission Labels ("NELs") for the purpose of controlling noise from construction activities and from the use of noisy construction equipment respectively.
- 4. Since 2008, we have not proposed any upward adjustment of these fees. The fees of all items are below the full cost recovery levels. In line with the "user pays" principle, it is government policy that fees and charges payable to the Government should in general be set at levels sufficient to recover the full costs of providing the goods and services. As such, we decide to increase the fees to achieve full cost recovery in one-go.
- <u>D</u> 5. The existing and proposed fees are summarised at Annex D.

#### THE AMENDMENT REGULATIONS

A - C 6. The Amendment Regulations at the Annexes A to C revise the fees concerned. It is proposed that the new fees will come into effect on 1 July 2016.

7. The legislative timetable is as follows –

#### **ECONOMIC IMPLICATIONS**

8. The revision of the fees should have minimal cost impact on the sector concerned and negligible impact on consumer prices.

#### FINANCIAL AND CIVIL SERVICE IMPLICATIONS

9. If the proposed fees revision is implemented, the estimated increase in revenue is about \$8.3 million per annum. There is no civil service implication.

#### OTHER IMPLICATIONS

10. The Amendment Regulations do not affect the current binding effect of the Ordinance and the subsidiary legislation. They are in conformity with the Basic Law, including the provisions concerning human rights. The proposal has no family, sustainability, productivity, environmental and gender implications.

#### **PUBLIC CONSULTATION**

- 11. On 27 November 2015, we consulted the Legislative Council Panel on Environmental Affairs (EA Panel) on our original proposals to gradually increase the fees. Considering that the fees would have minimal impact on the sector, Panel members urged the Government to revise the fees to achieve full cost recovery in one-go.
- 12. After considering the views of Panel members, we decided to revise our proposals. In February 2016, we consulted construction trade associations, construction equipment suppliers, and applicants for CNPs and NELs on the proposed revision of fees based on full cost recovery. They had no strong views against the proposed fees revision.
- 13. On 14 March 2016, we consulted the ACE and gained their support on the proposed increase in fees.

#### **PUBLICITY**

14. The Amendment Regulations will be published in the Gazette on 15 April 2016 and a press release will be issued on the same day. A spokesperson will be available to answer media and public enquiries.

Noise Control (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2016

#### **Explanatory Note**

This Regulation amends the Noise Control (General) Regulations (Cap. 400 sub. leg. A) to increase the fee payable on an application for a construction noise permit as set out below—

- (a) section 3(1) increases the fee payable on an application for such a permit for either or both of the following purposes—
  - (i) using powered mechanical equipment for carrying out construction work other than percussive piling between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m., or at any time on a general holiday;
  - (ii) carrying out prescribed construction work at any place within a designated area between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m., or at any time on a general holiday; and
- (b) section 3(2) increases the fee payable on an application for such a permit for carrying out percussive piling between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day, not being a general holiday.
