Presentation of views by deputations

4. At the invitation of <u>the Chairman</u>, a total of 56 deputations/individuals presented their views at the meeting. In gist, those who were in favour of the legislative proposal to ban ivory trade considered it a major cause of the brutal killing of elephants and rangers who had sacrificed their lives to protect the elephants. Those who were against the legislative proposal considered that the local ivory traders had nothing to do with elephant poaching as they were trading with legally imported ivory obtained from elephants which died of natural causes, and should be compensated for the loss of their private property and means of living as a result of the legislative proposal.

		 (a) the legislative proposal set out in the Bill was in conformity with the Basic Law, including the provisions concerning human rights, as it would not involve any formal expropriation of property or any de facto expropriation. The owners would retain possession of their ivory and there would not be any transfer of title of the owner's property; 	
		 (b) the owners' ivory would not be denied of all meaningful use. The ivory would still have other beneficial uses such as possession, donation, exhibition, etc The ivory could also have artistic or cultural uses; 	
		(c) in the absence of deprivation, it was unlikely that the right to compensation protected under Article 105 of the Basic Law would be triggered. The Administration considered that no compensation should be made to affected traders since the latter had already been given advance alert regarding the proposed trade ban and a reasonable and sufficiently long grace period of five years from 21 December 2016 to undergo business transformation and/or dispose of the ivory in their possession;	
		(d) the provision of compensation to licensed ivory traders would send a wrong message to lawbreakers that there was prospect of compensation which could result in proliferation of the poaching of elephants and the murder of rangers, and encourage the smuggling of illegal ivory into Hong Kong to launder with the legal stock for compensation.
