Waterworks (Amendment) Regulation 2017 ("the Amendment Regulation") Debate and voting arrangements

Object of the Amendment Regulation To amend the Waterworks Regulations (Cap. 102 sub. leg. A) to revise the requirements relating to the material standards for pipes or fittings installed in a fire service or inside service.

Joint debate

Secretary for Development ("SDEV")'s proposed resolution

- To amend section 7 of the Amendment Regulation to amend the new regulation 20(2) specifying that the Water Authority in exercising the relevant power relating to a departure from a prescribed specification for a pipe or fitting would only consider two factors: (a) the efficiency of the fire service or inside service in which the pipe or fitting is installed in providing a reliable and adequate supply of water; and (b) the quality of the water;
- to amend section 9 of the Amendment Regulation to add regulation 25(2A) which specifies that the Water Authority would consider the above two factors in exercising the power to relax regulations under regulation 25(2); and
- to amend section 10 of the Amendment Regulation:
 - to amend paragraphs 1, 3, 4 and 21 of new Part 1 as well as paragraph 9 of new
 Part 4 to Schedule 2, seeking to delete the relevant provisions related to cast iron
 pipe from the legislation as cast iron pipe is no longer used in the market; and
 - to amend paragraph 23 of new Part 1, to delete paragraph 1 of new Part 2 and to add new paragraph 1A of new Part 4 to Schedule 2, which are technical and textual amendments, to make the meaning of the relevant provisions clearer.
