3. At 1:37 pm, <u>the Chairman</u> said that he had made a ruling on the five motions proposed to be moved by Mr CHU Hoi-dick and Dr YIU Chung-yim under FCP 21 on 15 March 2017, and all five motions were ruled out of order. He would circulate the written ruling to the two Members and other members later.

4. <u>The Chairman</u> said that before the meeting today, Mr CHU Hoi-dick and Dr YIU Chung-yim had, further to the aforesaid five motions, proposed to move another five motions under FCP 21 on this agenda item, but as the time of submission of the motions proposed to be moved by Mr CHU and Dr YIU had failed to meet the notice requirement specified in FCP 21, he would not deal with the five further motions.
