63TR — Shatin to Central Link—construction of railway

works—advance works

The Finance Committee ("FC") continued with the deliberation on FCR(2017-18)10.

Monitoring mechanism of the Government and its effectiveness

2. In view of the cost overruns of the advance works of the Shatin to Central Link ("SCL"), <u>Dr Fernando CHEUNG</u> asked about the measures to be taken by the Administration to avoid cost overruns of the main works of SCL, as well as the estimated total amount of cost overruns of the entire project.

- 3. In response, the Under Secretary for Transport and Housing ("USTH") pointed out that the Administration was duty bound to control the project costs as far as possible and would achieve it by shortening the duration of works as much as possible, but the estimated amount of cost overruns of the entire project as calculated by the MTR Corporation Limited ("MTRCL") would only be available for review by the Administration by the latter half of 2017.
- 4. <u>Mr LEUNG Kwok-hung</u> enquired whether the decision on the mode of contract for implementing the project was made by the Administration or MTRCL. <u>The Director of Highways</u> ("D of Hy") responded that according to the entrustment agreement, it was the duty of MTRCL to determine the mode of contract to implement the project.

Motion to adjourn the discussion on agenda item FCR(2017-18)10

- 5. At 5:34 pm, Mr LEUNG Kwok-hung moved under paragraph 39 of the Finance Committee Procedure ("FCP") that discussion on FCR(2017-18)10 be adjourned. The Chairman proposed the question and directed that each member might speak once on the motion for not more than three minutes.
- 6. <u>Mr LEUNG Kwok-hung</u> briefed the meeting on his motion. <u>Mr LEUNG</u> considered that the cost overruns incurred by SCL advance works were unacceptable and the Administration had failed to provide the information requested by members to ease their worries.
- 7. Ms Claudia MO, Dr Fernando CHEUNG, Mr HUI Chi-fung, Dr YIU Chung-yim, Mr Nathan LAW, Mr CHAN Chi-chuen, Mr Andrew WAN, Mr Jeremy TAM, Dr Pierre CHAN, Mr CHU Hoi-dick, Dr LAU Siu-lai, Mr KWONG Chun-yu, Dr CHENG Chung-tai, Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung and Mr James TO spoke in support of Mr LEUNG's motion. In gist, they considered that the Administration should withdraw the paper for the item and submit it again in future as the Administration had not put forward specific proposals for cost control, officials attending the meeting had failed to provide comprehensive answers to the questions raised by members, and the contents of the papers provided by the Administration were either incomplete or misleading.

- 8. During the debate, Mr HUI Chi-fung was dissatisfied that members were only allowed to speak for three minutes. The Chairman remarked that the item had been discussed for four hours by the Public Works Subcommittee and more than 6 hours by FC. Besides, the Chairman had repeatedly reminded members to return to the Conference Room to raise questions. He observed that when he directed that it was the last round of questions, Mr HUI did not press the button to indicate his intention to speak. Considering that the Chairman had made an incorrect observation, Mr HUI Chi-fung raised a point of order. The Chairman said that he would neither deal with it nor make a ruling on it.
- 9. At the Chairman's request, <u>the Clerk</u> explained that at the time when Mr HUI Chi-fung pressed the button, it was an indication for waiting to speak for the last round of three minutes.
- 10. <u>Ms Starry LEE</u> declared that she owned properties along the alignment of SCL. The accounting firm she worked for was the auditor of MTRCL, but she was not involved in the related work. <u>Mr Tommy CHEUNG</u> declared that his wife owned properties along the alignment of MTR.
- 11. <u>Mr LEUNG Kwok-hung</u> spoke in reply in respect of his motion. <u>The Chairman</u> put the motion to vote. At the request of members, <u>the Chairman</u> ordered a division and the motion was negatived. The votes of individual members were set out in **Annex**. FC continued with the deliberation on item FCR(2017-18)10.

<u>Unfavourable ground conditions</u>

- 12. <u>Mr HUI Chi-fung</u> enquired whether the unfavourable ground conditions eventually detected through ground investigations were definitely unforeseeable.
- 13. In response, the Projects Director, MTRCL ("PD/MTRCL") pointed out that:
 - (a) in case of complex geology, investigation findings obtained from different investigation sites might not reflect the actual conditions; and
 - (b) with current technologies, site investigations could not ensure 100% accuracy.

- 14. <u>Mr Michael TIEN</u> asked whether MTRCL would step up site investigation work for its self-financing items in future. <u>Mr TIEN</u> enquired whether the Transport and Housing Bureau would instruct the Civil Engineering and Development Department to update its Geoguide. <u>Mr Jeremy TAM</u> expressed similar views.
- 15. <u>PD/MTRCL</u> said that site investigation work would be stepped up as far as possible in future. <u>D of Hy</u> said that the entrustment agreement required MTRCL to adopt the same high standards as those for implementing its projects.

Financial arrangements

16. Mr Andrew WAN requested the following information: the expenditure and nature of each contract awarded under 63TR, a comparison table showing the corresponding items under the application for additional provisions for 63TR, and whether an audit report for the funding application to meet the cost overruns concerned had been prepared by the Administration or MTRCL. Dr YIU Chung-yim considered that the Administration should engage independent auditors to verify the financial reports provided by MTRCL. He and Mr CHAN Chi-chuen requested the authorities to give a clear account of the data on the provision for price adjustments.

17. In response, <u>PD/MTRCL</u> pointed out that:

- (a) the cost overruns incurred by various items of works were clearly set out in PWSC(2016-17)43 and its enclosures; and
- (b) all estimates were examined by the Project Control Group and the authorities would provide related audit data as far as possible. The financial data provided by MTRCL were accurate.
- 18. <u>USTH</u> said that the financial data provided by MTRCL were believed to contain no misrepresentation.
- 19. Mr KWONG Chun-yu enquired whether the 50 to 60 projects that experienced cost overruns in the past were all carried out in recent years. USTH remarked that the projects were carried out between 2006 and 2015.

20. <u>Ms Claudia MO</u> was dissatisfied that LC Paper No. FC182/16-17(01) was provided by the Administration as late as in the morning of 16 June 2017, leaving members with no time to digest its contents. <u>USTH</u> said that they had spared no effort to prepare the paper within the shortest time possible.

Motion for the adjournment of further proceedings of the Finance Committee

- 21. At 7:01 pm, Mr CHAN Chi-chuen moved under FCP 39 that further proceedings of FC be then adjourned. As the scheduled ending time of the meeting was 7:25 pm, the Chairman directed that the meeting would end earlier at this juncture, and reminded members that motions proposed by members under FCP 37A would be dealt with at the meeting to be held on the following day.
- 22. The meeting ended at 7:02 pm.
