Report No. 15/16-17 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 12 April 2017.

The resolution moved by the Secretary for the Environment under section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance to amend this item of subsidiary legislation was passed at the Council meeting of 29 March 2017. As such, by virtue of Rule 49E(6) of the Rules of Procedures ("RoP"), no motion shall be moved under RoP 49E(2) in relation to this subsidiary legislation.

- 3. The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study item (1) in detail at its meeting on 24 February 2017. The Subcommittee made a verbal report at the House Committee meeting on 24 March 2017, and provided Members with a written report vide LC Paper No. CB(1)751/16-17 on 31 March 2017.
- 4. In respect of items (2) to (4), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these three items of subsidiary legislation.
- Note: The House Committee formed two subcommittees to study the following four items of subsidiary legislation at its meeting on 17 March 2017. Hon CHAN Hak-kan, Chairman of the first Subcommittee, and Hon YIU Si-wing, member of the second Subcommittee, have given notice to move proposed resolutions respectively at the Council meeting of 12 April 2017 to extend the period for amending these four items of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 10 May 2017.
