Pursuant to the decision made at the House Committee meeting on 28.10.16, these two subcommittees will not be activated until 14.11.16. If the number of proposed subcommittees on policy issues agreed to be appointed by the House Committee and Panels as at noon of 14.11.16 does not exceed the remaining vacant slots of subcommittees on policy issues (i.e. three), these two subcommittees can be activated immediately.
