1.	<p>(a) Refuse collection system in Hong Kong</p> <p>Members have raised concerns about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) how the design and management of relevant facilities, such as refuse collection points, will tie in with the implementation of municipal solid waste ("MSW") charging in future; (ii) collection and recovery of waste (in particular food waste) at public housing estates; and (iii) impact of outsourcing of refuse collection services on waste reduction and recycling. <p>[Note: Representatives from the relevant bureau/departments including the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department and the Housing Department will be invited to attend the meeting.]</p> <p>(b) Administration's written responses to deputations' views raised at the third meeting or in their written submissions</p>	Fourth meeting (February 2017)

4.	<p>Progress and effectiveness of producer responsibility schemes</p> <p>The Subcommittee would like to be briefed on the progress and effectiveness of producer responsibility schemes ("PRSs").</p> <p>[Note: The Panel on Environmental Affairs will receive updates on the progress of preparation for implementing the PRS on waste electronic and electrical equipment and the PRS on glass beverage containers in January and second quarter of 2017 respectively.]</p>	To be confirmed
