Update on the work of Create Hong Kong	9.1.2017	The Administration was requested to provide:  (a) breakdown of \$57 billion (being the value added of Hong Kong's creative industries in 2015) by 11 cultural and creative sectors, namely, arts, antiques and crafts; cultural education and library, archive and museum services; performing arts; film, video and music; television and radio; publishing; software, computer games and interactive media; design; architecture; advertising; and amusement services; and  (b) information regarding the performance indicators for assessing the effectiveness of the film-related projects supported by the Film Development Fund, such as box office receipts, since the establishment of Create Hong Kong in June 2009.
