4. Spectrum trading

The former Office of the Telecommunications Authority (replaced by the Office of the Communications Authority since 1 April 2012) appointed a consultant to study the feasibility of introducing radio spectrum trading in Hong Kong for facilitating economic and technically efficient use of this scarce public resource. In June 2016, the Administration indicated that it would conduct a study on the latest overseas experience including the updated market situation to chart the way forward.
