Supplementary Information on Civil Service-related Matters Featured in the 2017-18 Budget

When discussing the Legco Paper "Civil Service-related Matters Featured in the 2017-18 Budget" [No. CB(4)688/16-17(05)] at the meeting held on 20 March 2017, Members of the Legislative Council Panel on Public Service requested the Government to provide additional information on the following items:

- (a) the estimated number of trainees that would participate in various civil service training and development programmes in 2017-2018;
- (b) the posts and bureaux/departments (B/Ds) involved in the creation of about 400 civil service posts to replace non-civil service contract (NCSC) positions; and
- (c) details of the attachment programmes to companies/non-government organisations organised for civil servants in the past.

The Government's Response

(a) Estimated number of trainees that would participate in various civil service training and development programmes

2. The estimated number of trainees that would participate in various civil service training and development programmes in 2017-2018 are as follows:

- (b) Creation of civil service posts to replace NCSC positions
- 3. A breakdown of the posts by B/Ds and work types is set out at **Annex**.
- (c) Details of the attachment programmes to companies/ non-government organisations in the past
- 4. Government departments arrange attachment programmes for civil servants to local and overseas organisations to meet the development needs of the departments and the grades and to broaden the perspectives of civil servants. From 2014 to 2016, a total of 187 civil servants had been attached to local, mainland and overseas organisations. The attachment organisations include local and overseas companies, statutory bodies and international organisations, mainland and overseas government departments, such as Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation Secretariat, Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development, Interpol and World Customs Organisation. The attachment period ranges from one week to three years. The countries where the overseas attachment programmes were held include UK, USA, France, Australia, Japan, South Korea and Singapore.
