**Legislative Council Panel on Welfare Services
Follow-up Action for Meeting on 8 May 2017**

At the meeting of the Panel on Welfare Services on 8 May 2017, Members requested the Administration to provide the number of written submissions received during the consultation period which supported and objected the proposed legislation to implement the recommendations of the Law Reform Commission Report on Child Custody and Access (the proposed legislation), broken down by associations/groups and individuals.
