Finance Committee Follow-up action arising from the meeting on 17 July 2018 FCR(2018-19)42

Thank you for your email of 19 July 2018, requesting information on the number of cases penalised for late lodgement of import and export declarations, as a follow up to the Finance Committee discussion on the captioned document. We have consulted the Customs and Excise Department and would like to provide the following information for Members' reference.

As required by law, an import/export declaration should be lodged within 14 days after the importation/exportation of the articles. Otherwise, the importers/exporters concerned would be subject to a late lodgement penalty.

The table below sets out the number of overdue declarations verified by the Government and the late lodgement penalty imposed on the relevant importers/exporters in the past three years.
