List of follow-up actions arising from the PWSC special meeting on 15 January 2018

Thank you for your email of 16 January 2018. Our reply is as follows –

The preliminary feasibility assessment for Shui Wo Street Market Cooked Food Centre in Kwun Tong has been completed. The tenants concerned are being consulted on the details of the extent of works. They have already agreed on most of the proposed arrangements (including the installation of a new transformer room, emergency generator, air-conditioning and ventilation systems and electrostatic precipitators and so on in the market). Having said that, the Government still needs to discuss with the tenants on whether a cooked food stall would need to be deleted to ensure the provision of a means of escape. To this end, the Architectural Services Department (ArchSD) is looking into the matter and has planned to continue the discussion with the tenants at the coming meeting of the Market Management Consultative Committee.

After a consensus is reached between the Government and the tenants, ArchSD will immediately conduct a technical feasibility study and formulate a timetable for the works project so as to take forward the works. Funding proposal will also be submitted in accordance with the established procedures.
