### I. Confirmation of minutes of meeting

## Minutes of 31st meeting held on 6 October 2017

(LC Paper No. CB(2)13/17-18)

## II. Matters arising

## Report by the Chairman on her meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration

2. The Chairman said that she had conveyed to the Chief Secretary for Administration ("CS") her wish that the relationship between the executive authorities and the legislature would continue to improve in the new legislative session. CS advised that the Administration would strive to improve the relationship between the executive authorities and the legislature, and enhance the Administration's communication and interaction with Members and the public, bringing "a new atmosphere" to and creating a harmonious ambience in the society.

- 3. The Chairman further said that she and the Deputy Chairman had asked CS to meet with Members to discuss the agendas of meetings of the committees, including the Finance Committee, to understand Members' views. CS had responded that he was pleased to communicate and discuss with Members from different political parties and groupings the agendas of committee meetings. The Chairman added that CS had advised that the Legislative Programme for the 2017-2018 session would be provided shortly.
- 4. In response to Dr KWOK Ka-ki's enquiry whether CS had made any suggestions on the dates of his meetings with Members, the Chairman said that at her meeting with CS, CS had undertaken to meet with Members from different political parties and groupings. She would, at her next meeting with CS, follow up the matter and relay to CS Members' request for CS to arrange the meetings as soon as possible.

#### III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

# Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on <u>6 October 2017 and tabled in Council on 11 October 2017</u>

(LC Paper No. LS1/17-18)

- 5. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Legal Adviser</u> briefed Members on the report prepared by the Legal Service Division on 13 items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 152 to L.N. 164) which were gazetted on 6 October 2017 and tabled in Council on 11 October 2017.
- 6. Mr Holden CHOW considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the four items of subsidiary legislation relating to the commissioning of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Port (L.N. 153, and L.N. 161 to L.N. 163) in detail. Members agreed. Mr YIU Si-wing, Mr Holden CHOW and Ms Tanya CHAN agreed to join the subcommittee.
- 7. <u>Dr Priscilla LEUNG</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Trainee Solicitors (Amendment) Rules 2017 (Commencement) Notice (L.N. 164) in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Dr Priscilla LEUNG agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.
- 8. <u>Members</u> did not raise any question on the remaining eight items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 152, and L.N. 154 to L.N. 160).

9. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending the above 13 items of subsidiary legislation would be the Council meeting of 8 November 2017, or that of 29 November 2017 if extended by a resolution of the Council.
