**Report No. 6/17-18 of the House Committee on Consideration of  
Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments**

**Purpose**

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 7 February 2018.

**Subsidiary legislation considered**

2. The House Committee has considered the following items of subsidiary legislation:
