Follow-up on the meeting of the Legislative Council Panel on Security on 3 November 2017

During the discussion of agenda item IV at the meeting of the Legislative Council Panel on Security held on 3 November 2017, Hon CHAN Chi-chuen requested the Government to provide information on the number of visitors refused entry into Hong Kong with breakdown by the reasons of refusal. In addition, Hon POON Siu-ping asked about the number of Cambodian nationals who had applied for visas to take up employment and study in Hong Kong.
